Hans G. Forsberg, born February 2, 1930 in Flen, Sweden.

Hans G. Forsberg became a civil engineer in 1956 at the Royal Institute of Technology. He was 1959-1962 research engineer at the Isotope Technique Laboratory and was 1972-1980 chief executive officer of Öresundsvarvet AB. He was awarded the professor's name in 1982. During the 21st century he has been an executive member of the board of the Angpanneföreningen Research Foundation.

Hans G. Forsberg was elected in 1982 as a member of the Academy of Engineering Sciences for which he was also chief executive officer in 1982-1994. He was elected in 1994 as a foreign associate member of the American National Academy of Engineering.
