

**Dr Dovilė Pūraitė-Andrikienė** is an assistant professor at the Faculty of Law, Vilnius University, and a researcher at the Law Institute of the Lithuanian Centre for Social Sciences; she also heads the Legal System Research Department of this Institute. In 2017, she defended her doctoral dissertation 'Constitutional Justice Procedure in Lithuania: A Search for An Optimal Model' at the Faculty of Law of Vilnius University.

Dr Pūraitė-Andrikienė actively conducts research in the fields of Lithuanian and comparative constitutional law, constitutional justice, and human rights protection. She has written one monograph, two research studies, five chapters of monographs, and 14 research articles. The results of her research have been published in prestigious international journals and by internationally recognised publishers. Among her most important publications is the monograph *Lietuvoje įtvirtintas konstitucinio skundo institutas kaip žmogaus teisių apsaugos įrankis* (Constitutional Complaints in Lithuania as a Tool for the Protection of Human Rights), published in 2022, and the monograph *Legal Protection of Vulnerable Groups in Lithuania*, *Latvia*, *Estonia and Poland: Trends and Perspectives*, published by Springer in 2022 (scientific editor and co-author). In 2021, the researcher undertook research fellowships at the constitutional courts of European Union countries.

Dr Pūraitė-Andrikienė is active in international and national research and expert projects. She presents papers at international and national scientific conferences, contributes to the organisation of international conferences, writes articles on science dissemination, and carries out other science dissemination and expert activities. She teaches constitutional law and EU law at the Faculty of Law, Vilnius University. In 2021, she was awarded the Rector's Diploma for the Best Lecturer of Vilnius University Faculty of Law of Vilnius University2021.
