Prof. dr hab. Jan Jurkiewicz was born in 03-12-1946 in Ostrzeszów, Poland.

Position: senior professor.

Research interests: the history of the Grand Duchy of Lithuania in the 16th - 18th centuries, national relations in Lithuania and Belarus in the 19th and the first half of the 20th century, the beginnings of Lithuania in early modern historiography

In 1968 he graduated from the University of A. Mickiewicz in Poznan and worked there. Since 1997 – as extraordinary professor.
